Bus Travel for Students Entering Year 3 2015

At the end of the year all students in Year 2 with bus passes will be automatically taken off the bus company system as they progress from infants to primary level. Therefore, it will be necessary for those students to reapply for 2015. To be eligible for free bus travel, a primary school student must reside more than 1.6 kilometres radial distance from the centre of the school property, or 2.3 kilometres or more by the most direct practicable walking route to the nearest point of entry to the school. If you have received a bus pass application recently from Blue Mountains Bus Company for your student moving into Year 3 in 2015, please complete the form as soon as possible and send it to the school office for processing. All forms are due back by 21 November.
