Free BMCC Child Restraint Checks: By law children up to 7 years of age or under 145cm are required to be in a child restraint while travelling in a vehicle. On Saturday 2 December Blue Mountains City Council will be running free child car seat/booster checks from 9am – 1pm at the Blue Mountains City Council car park, 2-6 Civic Place, Katoomba. Experienced RMS authorised fitters will be there on the day to check and fit child car seats, booster seats, harnesses etc. The check is free, but any parts needed to make the restraint safer will be at the cost of the parents/carer (cash or eftpos available).
