- Music and Band lessons where students are actively involved in composing playing and appreciating music
- Students engaged in daily writing for a purpose and audience
- Opportunities for students to reflect on scripture and Catholic values
- High quality literature being enjoyed, shared and used . as mentor texts
- Physical Education lessons focused on developing skills, • promoting socialisation and team work
- Conversing in and learning about another language and it's culture (Italian)



Feed-back as an integral part of learning: teacher to student, student to teacher and student to student.

The knowledge, skills and attitudes we teach need to always be considered within the scope of how they ultimately influence a child's passion and compassion as a young person within a learning community. In visiting classes to honour and celebrate the wonderful learning taking place I am always in search of signs of that passion and compassion.
